

PLEASE NOTE CRITERIA

GENERAL CRITERIA

Artists and Schools

- You may apply for an artist's residency OR an artist's day. You may not apply for both.
- No school or artist is guaranteed an award and the scheme will be adjudicated by an independent selection panel. The number of awards will be dependent on the funding available to the County Arts Office.
- All award recipients will be required to sign a Memorandum of Understanding and Health and Safety checklist prior to initiating projects.

NEW CRITERIA FOR 2019-2020

Artists

- All successful artists are required to have adequate and comprehensive Public Liability Insurance to the value of (€ 6.5 million) indemnifying Clare County Council.

Artists

- In keeping with current national professional standards within the arts & education sector from 2023 Clare County Arts Office will only accept Artist in Schools applications from artists who have undertaken a Teachers Artists Partnership Course (TAP). This course is rolled out by the Clare Education Centre usually in August on an annual basis. Details of TAP are circulated through the Clare Arts Office mailing list and on the Clare Education Centre website.

Artists and Schools

- The Closing date for applications for the residency programme is Friday, 20th of September, 2019.

Projects will be assessed according to the following criterias below.

- Quality and innovation of the concept/idea for the proposal.
- Quality of the artists work and track record as demonstrated by CV and support images of work.
- Feasability of the proposed project, budget, time frame, number of students etc.
- Potential for the project to leave creative impact on the school.
