The Clare Placenames Committee also encourages, and where possible, assists local communities, schools and interested individuals to undertake research into placenames and field names. A Placenames Conference was held in County Clare in 2003 to further promote and

Reachtladh Comhdháil Logainmneacha sa bhliain 2003 chun spéis a chothú san ábhar maraon le aird an phobail a dhíriú ar oidhreacht na logainmneacha i gcoitine.

Tá sé tábhachtach go dtugann pé ainm nua a roghnófar soiléiriú ar dhreach-tíre na háite i gcomhthéacs an chultúir agus an stair logánta, ag tógaint nithe eile mar an eiceolaíocht, leagan amach na háite mar a bhí sa t-seanaimsir, daoine agus imeachtaí tábhachtacha san áireamh.

It is important that modern placenames reflect the local topography, history, culture or ecology, such as ancient fields, roads, people and significant events.

Placenames should be easily pronounced and the use of Irish language placenames is encouraged, where possible. Irish versions of names should be checked for correct spelling and grammar before inscribing the nameplate.

Ní mór d'aon dream a bhfuil sé i gceist acu dul i mbun tógála sa chontae teagmháil a dhéanamh le Chomhairle Contae an Chláir agus na Comhairlí Baile chun cead scríofa a fháil roimh ré maidir le húsáid ainm ar bith, go fiú úsáid ar an gcomhartha tógála féin.

Before commencing a proposed development, the developer must submit names to Clare County Council and to the Town Councils

for consideration by the Placenames Committee and for its written agreement.

Tá traidisiún saibhir, éagsúil ag baint le oidhreacht na logainmneacha i gContae an Chláir. Tá 2,401 bailte fearainn sa chontae agus tá ainm ar

leith ar gach ceann acu. Leiríonn na hainmneacha seo an chaoi ina bhfuil muintir an chontae agus fórsaí an nadúir araon tar éis dul i bhfeidhm ar dhreach-tíre an cheantair. Bhí ainm

ar leith ar na háiteanna is lú tráth dá raibh, gach páirc fiú.

County Clare has a rich and varied tradition of placenames. There are 2,401 townlands in the county, each with a distinctive name, reflecting the natural and man-made features in the locality. In the past every field and local area had its own identity.
